

The Visitor Control Center (VCC) is now open Monday through Sunday from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. After 10 p.m., guests must enter through Stony Lonesome Gate where they will be issued a 24-hour pass. All visitors must undergo on-the-spot background checks in compliance with the National Crime Information Center–Interstate Identification Index prior to being issued credentials.

Access requirements:

Non-DOD visitors should fill out a local area credential request form at: [LACRequest.pdf \(army.mil\)](#) and bring the completed form to the VCC located at 2107 New South Post Road in Highland Falls, N.Y.

In addition, visitors should bring a state-issued driver's license compliant with the Real ID Act of 2005. Check compliance at: <http://worldpopulationreview.com/states/real-id-compliant-states/>

Those without a valid driver's license, will need one of the following:

- U.S. passport or U.S. passport card.
- Permanent resident card or alien registration receipt card (Form I-551).
- Foreign passport with a temporary I-551 stamp or temporary I-551 with a printed notation on a machine-readable immigrant visa.
- Employment authorization document that contains a photograph.
- U.S. Military or draft record.
- U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Card.
- Transportation Worker Identification Card.
- Native American Tribal Document.
- In the case of a nonimmigrant alien authorized to work for a specific employer incident to status, a foreign passport with Form I-94 or Form I-94A bearing the same name as the passport and containing an endorsement of the alien's nonimmigrant status, as long as the endorsement has not yet expired and the proposed employment is not in conflict with any restrictions or limitations identified on the form.
