

Summer Swim Lessons

Swim lessons are available through CYS Youth Sports & Fitness program. Swim lessons are two week sessions comprised of eight 40 minute lessons based on American Red Cross standards.

Participants must be 5 years old and have a current (CYS) Services membership on file at Parent Central. Town of Highlands children registered in the Highland Falls and Fort Montgomery school district are eligible to enroll in swim lessons. Swimming Rules

All children under 14 years of age must pass the swim test to swim in the deep water. The deepwater swim test includes:

- 1. Tread water for 1 minute
- 2. Swim approximately 50 yards using freestyle stroke.
- 3. Swim approximately 50 yards using freestyle, backstroke, or breast stroke.
- 4. Get up on a dock without using a ladder.

All exercises for the swim test must be performed consecutively and without assistance. Improper or weak strokes could be grounds for failure. Lifeguards make the final decision of pass or fail. Completion does not ensure passing. Parents are not allowed to accompany swimmer during the swim test.

No smoking allowed at any of the facilities. The use of flotation devices or swimming aids are prohibited unless authorized by the facility manager on a case by case basis. Flotation devices must be USCG approved. A mandatory 15 minute rest period will be administered every hour at quarter to the hour for all patrons 13 years of age and under.

No fishing from the paddle boats or swimming dock.

Life jackets must be worn at all times for all who are boating.

Electric trolling motors only. No gas motors

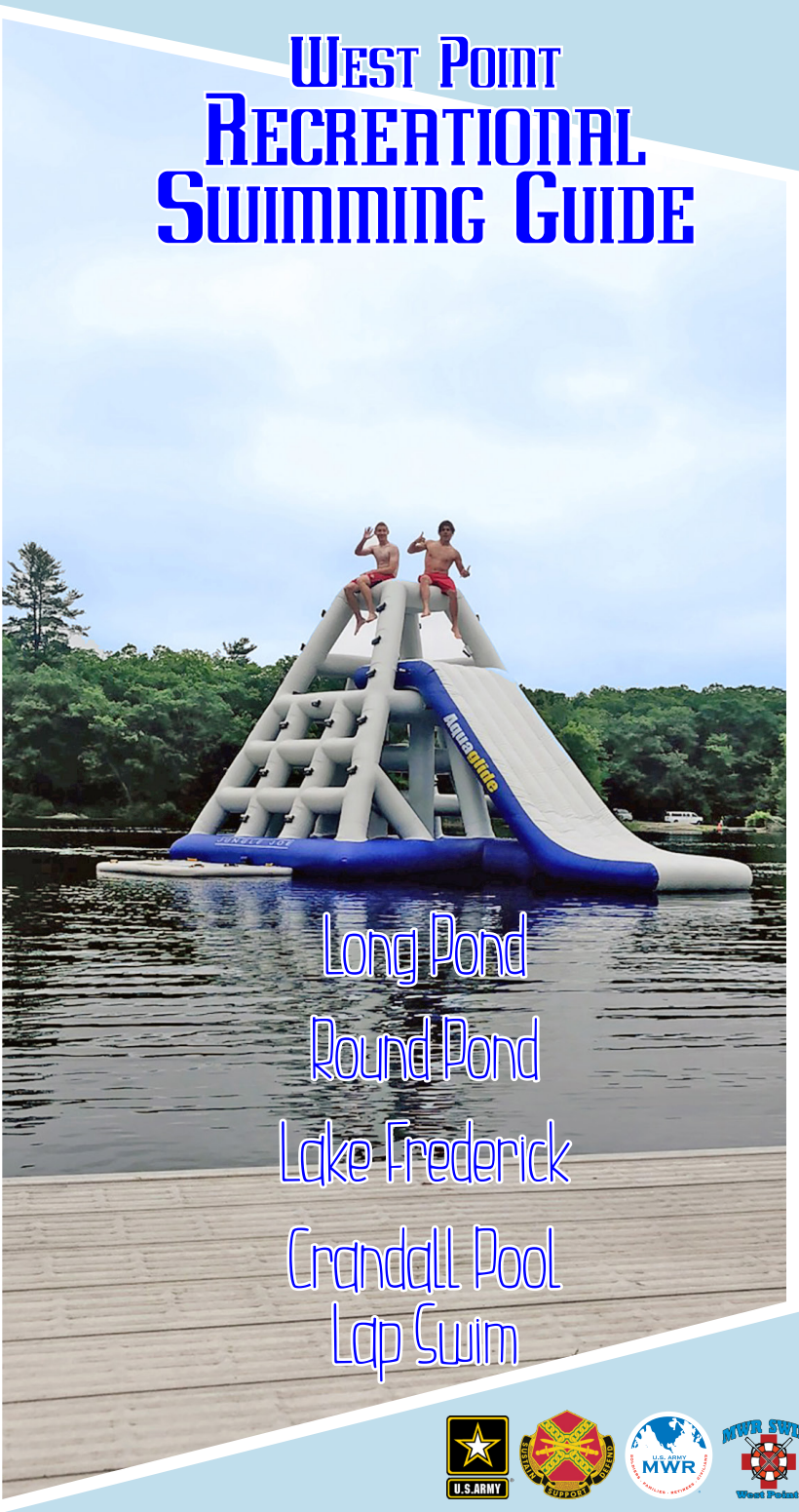
Food may be brought into all swimming areas except Crandall Pool. Alcohol and glass containers are prohibited.

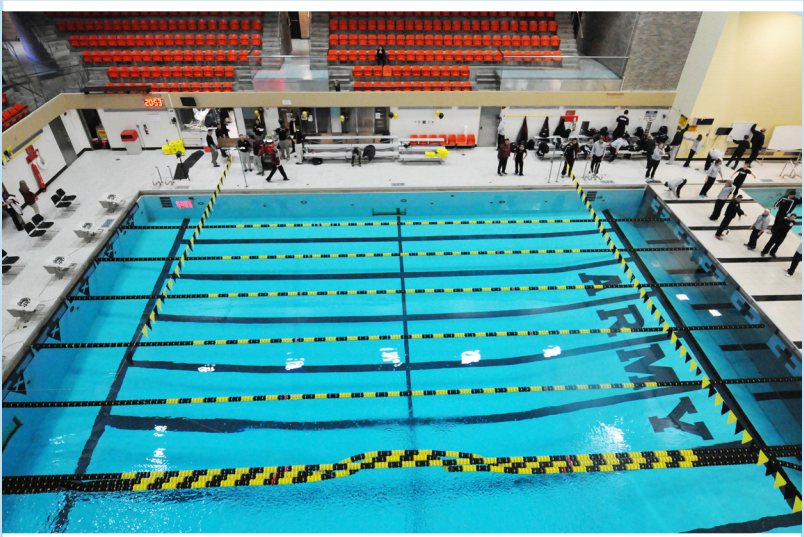

Long Pond recreation area, West Point's premier swim location is located off of route 293. A little over three miles off post on the left. Long Pond is a clear lake surrounded by a beach, pavilion and picnic areas. Lifeguards are on duty at the swimming beach during the summer months. Patrons must purchase a daily pass, punch card or season family splash pass at the administration check-in near the beach entrance or at the MWR Fitness Center prior to visiting.

Daily Visits:

\$5 for ages 14 and up

\$4 for ages 3 to 13, E1 - E6 and Cadets

Free for children age 2 and under.

Punch Cards:

\$46 for 12 punches, ages 14 and up,

\$36 for 12 punches, ages 3-13, E1 - E6 and Cadets

Free for children age 2 and under.

\$80, up to 8 immediate family members on one pass.
