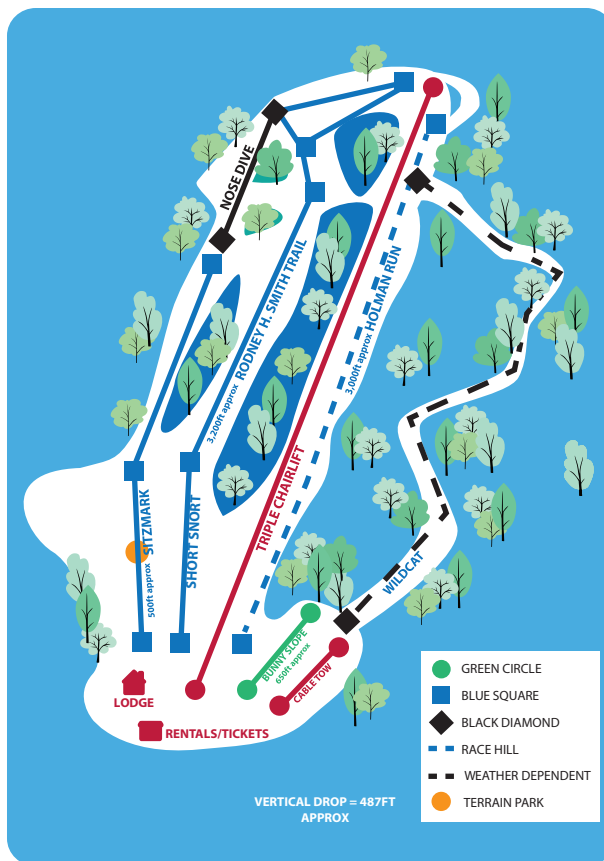
### OUR HISTORY

Victor Constant is conveniently located just outside the gates of the United States Military Academy in West Point, NY. This gem of an area has been a cherished traditional source of recreation for military families and the surrounding community for over 75 years.

In 1936, skiing was first attempted at West Point on a primitive ski slide at Delafield Pond. Three years later, the first trail was cut through the woods at Silver Deposit Hill, later named Victor Constant Ski Slope after Army Captain Victor Constant, who was instrumental in developing skiing at West Point.

During the 1940's several ski runs were cut & the first rope tow was added. A rustic log cabin with a warming stove was built, & the ski club and ski patrol were formed.

Victor Constant operates annually from December to March, weather permitting.



### From North

NYS Thruway (I-87) south: exit 17 Newburgh. Take I-84 east to exit 10 (Rte 9W south). Take 9W south 12.5 miles to Rte 218 exit. Follow Rte 218 for 1 mile, VCSA on right.

### From South

Palisades Pkwy north to Bear Mtn: take Rte 9W north for 3 miles, go through Ft. Montgomery to Rte 218. Follow Rte 218 for 1 mile, VCSA on right.

### From West

Rte 17/Rte 6 east: exit 130A for Rte 6 east to Bear Mtn. for 3.5 miles. Slight left to Rte 293 north for 6.8 miles. Slight left to Rte 218/Rte 293 north. Follow Rte 218 for 1 mile, VCSA on right.
