Simple Winter Safety Tips for Kids:

- ❖ Adjust winter clothing to your child's needs, don't forget the boots, gloves, and hats.
- ❖ When sledding, keep a safe distance from any obstacles. Sled feet first!
- ❖ When skiing, snowboarding, or ice skating, always wear a helmet.
- ❖ Keep exposure to the cold weather at a minimum. Monitor for frostbite: watch for discolored skin red, white, bluish in color and tingling or numbness. If symptomatic, move to a warm environment and apply warm water to the affected areas. Use blankets to raise the body temperature. Seek Medical attention!
