## DOG GROOMING

All grooming requirements will be discussed with customer and agreed to before grooming. A release will be signed for any dog requiring a complete coat clip (shave).

# LESSONS

Morgan Farm offers group and individual lessons, for beginner through advanced riders. Students learn basic horsemanship, equipment, and riding technique in either the English or Western style of riding.

Western riders have their roots in the days of the old west cowboy. The western saddle can be very ornate, made of tooled leather and metal or colorful trim, and also has a horn at its front. To the novice rider, the horn may seem like a safety handle, but it's actually where cowboys tie their ropes. Western riding is seen in rodeos and barrel racing.

English riders are easily recognized by their helmets, riding breeches and high black boots. The English saddle is made of smooth leather, metal stirrups, and has no horn. English riding is often associated with jumping and chase events.

Lessons are available for both half-hour and hour group, semi-private and private instruction.

# SUMMER RIDING CAMPS

Morgan Farm horseback riding summer day camps are held Mon.-Fri., 9am-3pm. Each week you can choose between 3 or 5 day camps. All levels offered based on age, experience and ability. Our camps are designed for children to have a hands on learning experience. Children are familiarized with basic safety, rules and procedures. Children will learn how to lead, brush, tack up and daily horse care. Riding at the beginner level will include learning to control a horse at the walk and trot. For those be-

yond the beginner level, instruction will be appropriate to build on existing skills and ability. Campers bring their own lunch and drinks. We have refrigerators for lunches and drinks. Please wear jeans and shoes/boots with a small heel. No riding in shorts/capris, sandals or sneakers allowed. All children are required to wear helmets when riding.
