## **General Information**

Our hours of operation will change as they normally do this time of the year. We are currently open for play at 0800 Tuesday through Sunday and for the first time this fall we are attempting to incorporate some shotgun starts at 1000 for all golfers interested in playing that day. By doing this we avoid the morning frost delays we get during this time of the year and maximize the amount of available golf opportunity that day. Please call or track these opportunities on our website as they emerge.

With the end of our outings season we are going to capture some opportunity as well to open the course on Mondays in November if the weather and conditions are conducive for a successful day of play. We will have these opportunities posted on the website as well going forward.

Golfers will see work being conducted on various surfaces during this time as well as other project style work to prepare for the 2025 season. With this, and a decline in weather conditions, we will be offering twilight rates all day through November until we close the course. Timing on the closure will be weather dependent, typically when snow flies. We will send notifications of our status when inevitability of closure presents itself.

We have been extremally patient in waiting for the green light to occupy the new clubhouse. We are hopeful to have access to it this winter so we can prepare for a successful start to the 2025 season. There are several punch list items that are still to be completed that are delaying occupancy of the facility. West Point DPW and MWR are working with the Army Corps of Engineers to ensure we get it right! This has resulted in some additional delays, but our expectations are high so that we provide the product our customers deserve and have waited way to long for. Updates on possible activity and opening timeframes will be posted as we move forward over the next few weeks/months.

Thank you to all for a very successful season. 2024 was one of the most successful in the history of the golf course and our staff have worked extremely hard to provide a service and product that aligns with our vision and mission, given the facility and equipment challenges we continue to face without a proper clubhouse, practice facility space and an aging cart fleet.
