Employment Readiness Program (ERP)



The Employment Readiness Program offers information and referral services and assistance to military Spouses; active duty military; retired military;

active Guard and Reserve; DoD civilians; and all immediate Family Members in the areas of employment, training and volunteer opportunities. The services are designed to give you the competitive edge necessary to secure employment and advance your career. Services include hiring events, career counseling and training, employment and education information, volunteer opportunities, internet job search and assistance in resume writing and goal setting.

ERP offers a Virtual Career Library, a 3D digital career library featuring over 6,000 pages of comprehensive job search education and career guidance resources. The Virtual Career Library also includes the following:

- Virtual career classroom
- Hiring and Employment news videos
- Digital career books
- College and career school finder
- Career exploration videos
- Virtual job bank, and more.

ERP also offers a downloadable App which features the following tools:

Military Spouse Employment Partnership (MSEP):

An expanding partnership between military Spouses seeking employment and corporate businesses committed to providing meaningful and portable careers. Military Spouses are encouraged to visit www.MSEPjobs.militaryonesource.mil to find employment opportunities and post resumes.



Military Spouses Career Advancement Account Program (MyCAA):

The program is offered to eligible military Spouses as part of the Office of the Secretary of Defense, Spouse Education and Career Opportunities (SECO) program.

- Eligibility restricted to spouses of active duty E1-E5, W1-W2, and O1-O2 serving on Title 10 orders.
- Financial assistance limited to \$4,000
- Financial assistance must be used three years from the start date of the first class.
- Financial assistance may only be used for an Associate Degree, occupational license or credential.
